The Health and Safety Advisor will provide support and expertise to all members of our Company's workforce including staff, contractors and other stakeholders to achieve our goal of zero harm.

Key Responsibilities

- Deliver technical expertise and continual improvement as part of a high-performance team delivering health and safety services across the Australian portfolio in a multi-site operation aligned to statutory, company requirements and expectations
- Support operations and other internal business teams to demonstrate visible leadership and specialist knowledge to reduce health and safety risk to prevent injury and illness
- Support the business in implementing, monitoring and compliance to the company HSE governance
- Support the hazard identification and risk assessment processes, and drive the development of a risk-based systems assurance culture
- Develop and maintain effective consultation arrangements with responsible managers and cultivate close liaison with internal and external stakeholders to identify strategic risk concerns and formulate effective responses to assure the safe and environmentally sound operation of the business
- Deliver safety inspections, safety observations as required and support timely close out of actions
- Promote the timely reporting of all incidents and assist in identification of remedial actions
- Perform health, safety and compliance audits to provide assurance that systems and their related procedures are implemented across the organisation
- Coach and mentor managers, staff and contractors to ensure appropriate HSE standards are met.
- Promote the company behavioural safety program across the business
- Collation of safety data for the compilation of monthly and other HSE and quality reports

The ideal candidate will possess minimum five years' hands on industry site experience, preferably in energy or related high-risk industry role, and hold or be working towards achieving formal qualifications (minimum Certificate IV) in Health and Safety, or relevant related discipline (degree qualifications are highly regarded). You must demonstrate sound

knowledge of WHS Legislation and relevant Australian Standards, and previous exposure to ISO systems, as well as ICAM and ChemAlert systems.

You will have well-developed interpersonal and communication skills with the ability to build effective relationships. You will be able to undertake routine and non-routine tasks with minimal supervision and display an ability to react positively to change and be able to manage conflicting priorities. Computer literacy using Microsoft Office including Word, Excel and PowerPoint at an intermediate level including computation of complex calculations, is essential. Demonstrated understanding of health and safety processes, including Permit to Work, Lock Out Tag Out, Incident Investigation, Contractor Management, Emergency Response, Risk Management, and Training and Competency is essential. Cert IV in Training and Assessment will be highly regarded. You must have a high level of accuracy and attention to detail with the ability to write effective reports. You will have a proven track record in HSE compliance management and monitoring and will be qualified as a lead Auditor.

Candidates must possess a current drivers' licence and will undergo drug and alcohol screening as well as a criminal history check. The role is based in Brisbane however, you must be willing and able to undertake regular local and interstate travel as required.
