- Perform regular inspection and maintenance of above equipment to a high standard;
- Undertake electrical and mechanical fault-finding, repairs and reporting.
- Monitor the process to ensure optimum output.
- Carry out routine housekeeping duties.
- Utilise the Pronto Maintenance Management and Quality Assurance Systems as part of the daily functions.
- Maintain warehouse and stock inventory.
- Actively ensure own health and safety and the health and safety of others through understanding and implementing workplace health and safety obligations.
