- Operate and maintain equipment and systems associated with a modern Gas Power Plant or equivalent heavy industrial experience
- Undertake electrical and mechanical fault-finding, repairs and reporting as necessary
- Carry out routine housekeeping duties and inspections as required
- Create and maintain Work Orders and Pm schedules using Pronto CMMS system
- Assist with maintaining warehouse and stock inventory to appropriate levels
- Drive the safety culture by example with continuous improvement as a key aspect, assisting with implementation and training of new processes as required
- Support and comply with all company policies and procedures
- Any other duties appropriate to the level and responsibility of the position as required
