Key Responsibilities will include:

- Drive safety leadership and actively promote Health & Safety through setting clear expectations for measurable safety behaviours, as well as demonstrate visible safety leadership through safety conversations, sharing safety learnings and conducting safety verifications on site.
- Lead small projects and shutdown work as required including HW Switching and electrical compliance.
- Engage, manage and supervise contractors to deliver capital works projects on time and to budget.
- Liaise with various departments such as engineering, asset management and planning to develop scope and engage appropriate contractors to develop resource plan and scheduling of works to deliver program of capital works and rectification works as required.
- Assist with the development of SIB/DOCs budget and cost control as well as AFE development and work order management.
- Monitor the process to ensure optimum output and manage down time and maintenance in line with station asset management strategies while maintaining operational compliance with approvals, legislation and contracts
- Use Maintenance Management and Quality Assurance systems as well as manage change in line with EDL's systems in consultation with Engineering and Asset Management functions.

The successful applicant will be enthusiastic and show commitment and demonstrate initiative to achieve excellent working standards.

A sound understanding of HSE requirements and previous experience leading the delivery of projects is essential.

Experience in the maintenance of large reciprocating engines, management and delivery of projects, and SCADA control systems will be an advantage as will a Mechanical or Electrical Trade background.
